

## **FCA SMALL GRANT PROGRAM**



WHAT IS THIS?

Officially approved FCA clubs/affiliates can usually secure small amounts of funding from their college/university to support their goals and activities (e.g. \$300-500). Additional funding for bigger events on campus (i.e. conferences, forums, etc.) sometimes can be available through other academic offices (e.g. Office of the Provost, Dean, etc.). FCA groups interested in securing funds for their off campus, community service work can apply here for this Small Grant Program.

WHO Can Apply?

Only approved FCA clubs/affiliates

**Funding AVAILABLE?** 

\$100-500 per application when funding is available

How OFTEN Can FCA Clubs Apply?

Application submissions are unlimited. But *FCA* groups can only be approved for funding **TWICE** during any academic year.

**Any RESTRICTIONS?** 

FCA Small Grant Program only supports requests that involve activities within the **COMMUNITY SERVICE** goal involving Anti-Bullying or

Child Abuse Prevention work in the community.

APPLICATION and DEADLINES

The FCA Small Grant Application is **downloadable** from the FCA National website (<a href="http://futurechildadvocates.org">http://futurechildadvocates.org</a>) and can be submitted anytime between **August-April** of each year.
